Friday, Jul 23: 125 AQI Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups **Orange** Ozone

Saturday, Jul 24: 105 AQI Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups **Orange** Ozone

July 23 - WARNING! Ozone levels are forecast to reach the unhealthy for sensitive groups category throughout New Jersey due to sunny skies, hot temperatures, and southwest winds. Sensitive individuals, including the very young, the elderly, and persons with respiratory diseases such as asthma, should avoid strenuous outdoor activities during the afternoon and early evening hours. Fine particle levels are expected to reach the moderate category across the Garden State due to high humidity. June 24 - WARNING! Ozone levels are forecast to reach the unhealthy for sensitive groups category throughout New Jersey due to sunny skies, hot temperatures, and southwest winds. Sensitive individuals, including the very young, the elderly, and persons with respiratory diseases such as asthma, should avoid strenuous outdoor activities during the afternoon and early evening hours. Fine particle levels are expected remain in the moderate category across the Garden State due to high humidity. June 25 - Ozone levels are forecast to reach the high moderate category throughout the Garden State due to northwest winds, sunny skies, and high temperatures. Fine particle levels are expected to stay in the moderate category due to high humidity. June 26 - Ozone levels are forecast to reach the moderate category throughout the Garden State due to northwest winds, sunny skies, and slightly lower temperatures. Fine particle levels are expected to reach the moderate level due to humidity.

AQI Values	Levels	Colors
0-50	Good (receive daily forecast)	Green
51-100	Moderate	Yellow
101-150	Unhealthy for Sensitive Groups	Orange
151-200	Unhealthy	Red
201-300	Very Unhealthy	Purple
301+	Hazardous	Maroon
