

Cape May County

Cape May County Fare-Free Transportation Program offers transportation to county residents who are 1) aged 60 or older; 2) disabled; 3) Veterans or their spouses; 4) of low income.

Modified fixed-route bus service is provided to the 16 municipalities in the county at least two times per week to a local shopping area. Appointments are not necessary for this service, you need only to be on the corner anywhere along the route. If anyone is unable to access the route due to disability, arrangements can be made for pickup closer to the individual's location by calling our reservation number.

Door-to-door and curb-to-curb (demand response) service is provided to all areas of Cape May County and selected areas of Atlantic County, Camden, Philadelphia, and Wilmington, Delaware. It is necessary to make an appointment to use this service at least two working days in advance of the trip to guarantee the ride.

- Required for Medical appointments only
- Two working days notice required
- Call for an appointment between 9am-3pm
- Have Rideshare ID number ready when calling Fare-Free Transportation.

Wheelchair Accessible. If accessible service is needed, riders must notify Fare-Free Transportation when making an appointment.

Riders must have an ID card issued by Fare-Free to ride any of the buses. To receive a card, schedule, or make an appointment, please call **(609) 889-3700** between the hours of 8a.m. and 4:30p.m., Monday through Friday.

Cancellations

Call to cancel rides. Riders may do this by calling **(609) 889-3700**, seven days a week, twenty-four hours a day. Dial and follow the instructions.

NJ TRANSIT



Many **NJ TRANSIT** buses are lift-equipped and are marked on the schedule with a "W." Some routes require a reservation for a lift-equipped bus to allow a person using a mobility device to board. Call (800) 772-2287 (same number for TTY) for a reservation. Kneeling buses allow the front step to be lowered and are marked with a "**KNEELING BUS**" decal.

NJ TRANSIT's Reduced Fare Program is for senior citizens 62 and older and passengers with disabilities. Senior citizens and persons with disabilities get the reduced fare by showing their valid NJ TRANSIT Reduced Fare ID/ Card, Medicare card or other valid form of identification. Applications for the NJ TRANSIT Reduced Fare ID/Card can be found at most local banks, savings and loan associations or county Offices of Aging, or by calling NJ TRANSIT at **973-378-6401**.

NJ TRANSIT's Access Link is for people whose disability prevents them from using existing local bus service. For information on how to apply for **Access Link** call (800) 955-2321, TTY (800) 955-6765 and an information packet will be sent to you. To determine eligibility, an interview will be set up and an application filled out. If you are eligible to ride **Access Link**, you will receive an I.D. number. Those using **Access Link** must be within 3/4 of a mile of a regular bus route and follow the same hours.

PATCO Speedline



The **PATCO Speedline** offers reduced fares for senior citizens (65 and older) and persons with disabilities (no age specified). Elevators and full accessibility are available at Lindenwold, Woodcrest, Broadway, 8th/Market, and 15th/Locust Street Stations. In addition, escalators are available at Ashland, Haddonfield, Westmont, Collingswood, Ferry Avenue, and 12th/13th/Locust Street Stations. To be eligible for the reduced fare, apply at the Broadway Station (Walter Rand Transportation Center in Camden). The reduced fare is available during the off peak hours of 9a.m. to 4p.m. and 7p.m. to 6a.m., Monday through Friday, and all day Saturday and Sunday.
