## NJ TRANSIT



Many **NJ TRANSIT** buses are lift-equipped and are marked on the schedule with a "W." Some routes require a reservation for a lift-equipped bus to allow a person using a mobility device to board. Call (800) 772-2287 (same number for TTY) for a reservation. Kneeling buses allow the front step to be lowered and are marked with a "**KNEELING BUS**" decal.

**NJ TRANSIT's Reduced Fare Program** is for senior citizens 62 and older and passengers with disabilities. Senior citizens and persons with disabilities get the reduced fare by showing their valid NJ TRANSIT Reduced Fare ID/Card, Medicare card or other valid form of identification. Applications for the NJ TRANSIT Reduced Fare ID/Card can be found at most local banks, savings and loan associations or county Offices of Aging, or by calling NJ TRANSIT at **973-378-6401**.

**NJ TRANSIT's Access Link** is for people whose disability prevents them from using existing local bus service. For information on how to apply for **Access Link** call (800) 955-2321, TTY (800) 955-6765 and an information packet will be sent to you. To determine eligibility, an interview will be set up and an application filled out. If you are eligible to ride **Access Link**, you will receive an I.D. number. Those using **Access Link** must be within 3/4 of a mile of a regular bus route and follow the same hours.

## PATCO Speedline



The **PATCO Speedline** offers reduced fares for senior citizens (65 and older) and persons with disabilities (no age specified). Elevators and full accessibility are available at Lindenwold, Woodcrest, Broadway, 8th/Market, and 15th/Locust Street Stations. In addition, escalators are available at Ashland, Haddonfield, Westmont, Collingswood, Ferry Avenue, and 12th/13th/Locust Street Stations. To be eligible for the reduced fare, apply at the Broadway Station (Walter Rand Transportation Center in Camden). The reduced fare is available during the off peak hours of 9am to 4pm and 7pm to 6am, Monday through Friday, and all day Saturday and Sunday.

Transportation services are available to Gloucester County residents who are

- Senior Citizens (60 years and older)
- Permanently or temporarily disabled
- Residents
- Medicaid eligible residents
- Rural residents
- Veterans
- Dialysis patients
- Radiations and/or chemotherapy patients
- Therapy (physical/occupational)
- Children (under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a responsible adult)

### SENIOR TRANSIT SERVICE FEATURES:

- Non-Emergency Medical Transportation
- Curb-to-curb transportation
- Access to health care providers
- Feeder service to NJ Transit bus service
- Limited access to essential personal business appointments
- Lift equipped buses
- Service animals, respirators, and portable oxygen tanks permissible

## MUNICIPAL TRANSIT SERVICES:

The following municipalities have their own *free (unless stated otherwise)* bus service for senior citizens and persons with disabilities (individuals must be residents of the municipality). The schedules within each municipality vary. Please call the phone numbers listed for each municipality to find out days, times, and stops.

### CLAYTON BORO - (856) 881-3778

- Open to all senior and disabled residents
- **Reservations:** 1 day in advance
- **Destination:** Clayton only
- **Availability:** Monday-Friday. Call for times
- Wheelchair accessible
- Door side service
- Services: Medical and business appointments and shopping

### DEPTFORD TWP. - (856) 228-4719

- Seniors 60+ and disabled
- **Reservations are required**
- **Destination:** Deptford only
- **Availability:** Call for days and times
- Wheelchair accessible
- Door side service
- Services: Shopping and banking

### FRANKLIN TWP. - (856) 629-5568

- Open to all residents over 15
- **Reservations:** Call in advance
- **Destination:** Nutrition Center and department stores. Call for days and stores served
- **Availability:** Nutrition Center: Monday, Thursday, Friday. Shopping: Tuesday and Thursday - Call for times
- Wheelchair accessible
- Door side service

### GLASSBORO BORO - (856) 881-1515

- 60 + or disabled
- **Reservations are not required**
- **Destination:** Glassboro (Bus follows a specific route. If appointments are within routes driver will stop.)

- **Availability:** Monday-Friday. Call for times
- Wheelchair accessible
- Services: Medical and business appointments and shopping
- Pick up pass and schedule at Parks and Recreation Department. I.D. required.

### LOGAN TWP. MUNICIPAL - (856) 467-2585

- Seniors or disabled
- **Reservations not required**
- **Destination:** Bridgeport only
- **Availability:** Call for days, times, and stops
- Wheelchair accessible
- Services: Shopping trips only

### MANTUA TWP. - (856) 468-1500

- Seniors and disabled
- **Call for reservations**
- **Destination:** Mantua only
- **Availability:** Call for days and times
- Wheelchair accessible
- Door side service
- Services: Shopping and special entertainment trips only

### MONROE TWP. - (856) 728-9840

- Open to all residents
- **Reservations:** Doctors appt. (3-4 days in advance), Shopping (call early morning - 8:30am)
- **Destination:** Monroe Twp. only
- **Availability:** Monday-Thursday 8am to 4pm
- Wheelchair accessible (someone must be there to put wheelchair on bus)
- Door side service
- Services: Medical appointments and shopping

### PITMAN BORO - (856) 582-4766

- Seniors 60+
- **Reservations not required**
- **Destination:** Pitman
- **Availability:** Call for days, times, and stops
- Wheelchair accessible
- Services: Shopping trips only

### WASHINGTON TWP. - (856)256-0707

- 55+ and disabled (must be able to get on and off the bus alone)

- **Reservations:** Reservations for medical appointments can be made the same day. Reservations for shopping trips must be made on Monday or Wednesday.

- **Destination:** Washington Twp only
- **Availability:** Call for days and times
- Wheelchair accessible
- Door side service
- Services: Medical and business appointments and shopping

### WENONAH BORO - (856) 468-3001

- Seniors and disabled
- **Reservations not required**
- **Destination:** Wenonah only
- **Availability:** Monday and Wednesday. Call for times and stops.
- Wheelchair accessible
- Services: Shopping and amusement trips only

### WESTVILLE BORO - (856) 456-0030

- Seniors and disabled
- **Reservations not required**
- **Destination:** Westville only
- **Availability:** Call for days, times, and stops
- Wheelchair accessible
- Services: Local shopping only

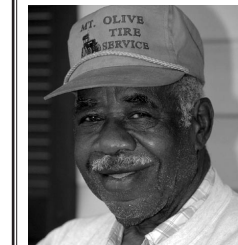
### WEST DEPTFORD TWP. - (856) 228-4749
