I-295 Southbound Lane Closures in Burlington County to Begin Monday, June 7th, 2010

NJDOT has informed us of the following:

Beginning Monday, June 7th, motorists traveling on I-295 Southbound between Exit 57 in Burlington and Exit 45 in Mount Holly should anticipate delays of up to 45 minutes or more during the evening rush hour due to construction.

This work will require reducing the number of Southbound travel lanes from 3 lanes to 2 lanes 24 hours a day. Only 2 travel lanes will be available to southbound traffic in the construction zone between Exit 45 and Exit 57. A new traffic pattern is anticipated to be established on or about June 18th.

Motorists are strongly advised to consider using the New Jersey Turnpike or US 130 as alternate routes around this construction zone.
