

Ben Franklin Bridge Lane Closures

On Monday, August 30, the Benjamin Franklin Bridge south walkway is reopening to the public. Walkway hours are 6am to 9pm daily. With the reopening of the south walkway the north walkway will be closed to the public.

The Delaware River Port Authority is a regional transportation agency. DRPA owns and operates the Benjamin Franklin, Walt Whitman, Commodore Barry and Betsy Ross Bridges, PATCO and the Philadelphia Cruise Terminal. The DRPA also owns the RiverLink Ferry.

Betsy Ross Bridge Lane Closures

Mon 8/23 thru Fri 8/27 beginning at 630am Mon and ending at 2pm Fri the right hand eastbound lane will be closed for repairs.

Mon 8/23 thru Wed 8/25 between 616am and 4pm each day the ramp from the betsy ross bridge to northbound route 130 will be closed for guide rail repairs.

From Mon 8/30 thru Thu 9/2 the Right Hand Westbound and Right Hand Eastbound lanes will be closed for repairs. The Westbound Lane will reopen Friday, 9/3 at 130pm.

The Eastbound Lane will reopen Friday, 9/3 at 2pm.

Walt Whitman Bridge Lane Closures

Mon 8/23 thru Thu 8/26 between 9pm and 5am each day lanes will be closed on the ramp connecting the eastbound bridge with the southbound freeway for strip seal replacement.

Mon 8/23 thru Thu 8/26 between 9pm and 5am each day lanes from the northbound freeway to the westbound bridge will be closed for strip seal replacement.

Mon 8/30 thru Fri 9/3 between 9am and 2pm each day the right hand westbound lane will be closed for wall and sign repairs.

Mon 8/30 thru Thu 9/2 between 9pm and 5am each day lanes on the ramp connecting the northbound freeway with the westbound bridge as well as the ramp connecting the eastbound bridge with the southbound freeway will be closed for strip seal replacement.
